
Saturday June 3

Glasgow, Scotland

After a hearty breakfast we'll depart Carlisle and head to Glasgow, Scotland. Glasgow Cathedral & Necropolis

This morning after breakfast we'll visit the **Glasgow Cathedral and Necropolis.** Consecrated in 1197, the Cathedral has one of the most impressive post-war collections of stained-glass windows in Britain. It remains a sturdy and impressive example of Scottish gothic architecture both inside and out. Nearby is Glasgow's Necropolis, dating back to 1833. We'll then visit a **local Brewery** for lunch and a few pints. Afterwards you'll have the afternoon on your own to explore this wonderful city and enjoy dinner at your leisure. Perhaps check out one of the wonderful museums in the city, shop, and dine in one of the many local pubs!

Monday June 5

Heading to Inverness

This morning after breakfast we say goodbye to Glasgow and head to Inverness. We'll travel alongside the famous Loch Lomond, renowned for its unsurpassed beauty. We will drive through the deep valley of Glencoe, notorious for the Campbell massacre of the Clan MacDonald in 1692, and we will stop at the spot where Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban was filmed. This is the former location of Hagrid's Hut. The set has now been removed and the hillsides returned to their natural state. We continue on through Fort William and stop at the Spean Bridge Woollen Mill, which offers a good selection of quality Scottish goods. After lunch we reach the mysterious Loch Ness, taking in all the breathtaking scenery that surrounds it. Make sure to keep an eye out for 'Nessie!' Finally reaching Inverness, we will check-in to our hotel, and enjoy dinner together this evening.

Culloden Battlefield & Clava Cairns

After breakfast today we'll tour Inverness. We'll stop at the historical **Culloden Battlefield**, where you'll learn the true story of where the 1745 Jacobite Rising came to an end. We'll continue on, visiting the prehistoric site of **Clava Cairns**, the well-preserved Bronze Age cemetery dating back 4,000 years. We'll have free time for lunch before stopping at **Highland House of Fraser** Kiltmakers and Visitor Center where you can shop for kilts, textiles, highland dress accessories, jewelry, and much more! We'll then head back to the hotel where you'll have the rest of the evening at your leisure.

Thursday June 8

Blair Castle & Pitlochry

Along the way we'll visit Blair Castle, the last castle in the British Isles to be besieged, during the last Jacobite rising in 1746. We'll stop for lunch in Pitlochry, one of Scotland's most vibrant and charming places to visit. In the heart of Scotland with beautiful scenery, rich clan history, fine food! Perhaps try some Haggis (liver, heart & lungs of a sheep minced with beef and spices) with a pint. We'll then continue on to Edinburgh head to our hotel to check-in and have the rest of the evening to explore Edinburgh at your leisure!

Saturday June 10

Hadrian's Wall & Manchester

After breakfast we'll depart Edinburgh and head to Manchester to prepare for our departure back to the USA! Along the way we'll stop for lunch and tour **Hadrian's Wall in Carlisle**. This World Heritage Site is said to be the most important monument built by the Romans in Britain, still evoking a strong sense of standing on the edge of an empire. For around three centuries, Hadrian's Wall was a vibrant, multi-cultured frontier sprawling almost 80 miles coast-to-coast. Built by a force of 15,000 men in under six years, it's as astounding today for its sheer vision as it is for its engineering. Milecastles, barracks, ramparts and forts punctuate a diverse landscape that provides a dramatic backdrop. Then we'll continue on to our Manchester Airport Hotel where we'll have our last group dinner together.
